WHAKATIKEI STREAM BRIDGE

Our team have recently completed the Whakatikei Stream Bridge. This makes up part of the Hutt River Trail, a scenic walking and cycling track to visit next time you're in the area.

Our team prefabricated this 20 metre glulam bridge & approach boardwalks at our plant in Levin and it went to site ready for the install & finishing touches.

Great work by the Upper Hutt City Council & Frame Group who designed this bridge. It was opened successfully on the 23rd of October.

If you're wanting to check it out, access is through Cory Jane Grove, This bridge will link Riverstone Terraces to Totara Park and create another bridge to bridge link (Moonshine to Totara Park bridges) to further open up the recreation value of the Hutt River corridor and add to the Hutt River Trail concept.
