TURITEA BRIDGE

Earlier in the year our team completed the Turitea Stream Bridge. An 11m glulam bridge, our team prefabricated this structure at our plant based in Levin. It arrived at site ready to go and the installation ran very smoothly.

BATON RIVER BRIDGE

A new structure is now open along the Tasman Taste Trail. The Edifice Team worked on this suspension bridge from late last year and it was completed in March 2022.

A both technical and practically demanding structure to set out and build. Towers were prefabricated in our yard then partly dismantled to enable transport to site. All foundation posts and anchors were precast, transportable to site and craned onto surveyed and graded surfaces.

All parties involved collaborated well to ensure everything came together smoothly.

The Tasman Taste Trail is now 168km long and can be experienced in short sections or as a 3-5 day loop cycling track. If you want to have a look at the Edifice Structure, it is along the section between Tapawera and Woodstock.



TAMAKUKU TERRACE

Our part is now complete at the Tamakuku Terraces in Palmerston North. This glulam bridge was prefabricated and installed by our team earlier this year.
